

Family Definition: Background

- City Council asked staff to review the Family definition, particularly the rule of three (limit of no more than 3 unrelated)
- The current definition doesn't reflect today's reality and is inconsistent with recent Federal Court decisions
- Changing demographics include:
 - Rapidly aging population
 - Fewer people getting married
 - Fewer people having kids
 - Smaller household sizes

Family Definition: Key Principles

- Protect health and safety
- Accommodate the very changed reality of "family"
- Provide housing choice that is responsive to the new reality of family while considering neighborhood character
- Respect the privacy of residents
- Consider legal and enforcement issues associated with the Family definition

Character

Focus on residential building design

Privacy

 Focus on privacy of residents by not requiring a permit or registration

Density

 Focus on limiting the number of people per room and/or requiring a minimum amount of living space per person Which approach do you prefer?
